

Equine Vaccinations

Vaccination is an essential component of an equines annual health plan. All horses that are exposed to other equines either at shows or livery must be vaccinated for equine influenza.

Vaccination protocol for equine influenza is as follows;

Primary Vaccination (from 6 months of age)

- First Vaccination (Influenza and Tetanus)
- Second Vaccination (Influenza and Tetanus) Three weeks after the first.
- Third Vaccination (Influenza) Five months after the second
- Thereafter an annual vaccination is required WITHIN the year for influenza and every second year for tetanus.

All equines should be vaccinated for Tetanus even if they are not exposed to other equines. This involves a primary course and is often included in the equine influenza vaccinations above but also can be given separately.
